Audition Details

LPC audition and casting will be held at the end of June. Dancers need to wear all black and hair must be pulled back into a bun. Please bring all necessary shoes.

Cost Requirements

There is a one time registration fee that includes all rehearsals, choreography, and costume rental.

Weekend Obligations

There will be minimal amount of weekend obligations for LPC members. There will be some dress rehearsals as we get closer to the performance date.

Classes Requirements

All LPC members must be enrolled in Ballet, Jazz, and LIT/ Performance Company.

Age Requirement

Any dancer auditioning for LPC must be in Kindergarten and up.

Summer Requirements

LPC members must attend LDA's summer training in July, as this will be where all Gala choreography is taught. This will be July 14th-18th.

What are the dates and location of the performance?

LPC's Winter Gala will be held on December 5th at the Jefferson Theater.

Will there be an attendance policy?

Members will be allowed to miss 3 days of dance each semester.

Do we purchase costumes?

Costume rental is included in your registration fee.

Is LPC a competitive team?

LPC is a performance company, which differs from LDA's competitive team. The only requirement for LPC member's is the Winter Gala performance.

Will the show change each year?

The Winter Gala choreography will change every few years. Our goal is to create a memorable performance for our community.

How does this differ from recital?

LPC is a winter themed show with two acts. This show was created for dancers who are interested in becoming more involved at LDA and who are looking for more performance opportunities.

How many dances will I be in?

Each dancer will be placed in at least one performance piece, but this will vary for each dancer.

What are the benefits of my dancer auditioning for LPC?

Dancers who join LPC will have more opportunities to learn from the best choreographers and teachers. They will also have more performance opportunities. Through this, your dancer will receive more training and time with instructors who will work towards their short and long term dance goals. LDA's goal is to create a space for ALL dancers to be involved and invested into our dance family.
